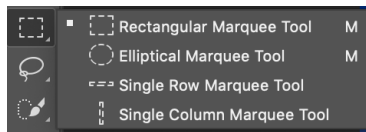
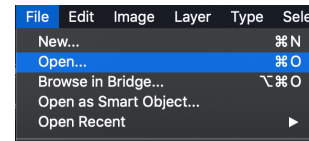


## Photomontage in Photoshop

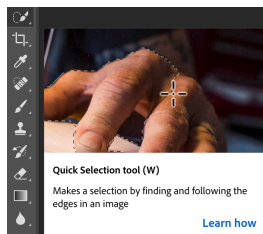
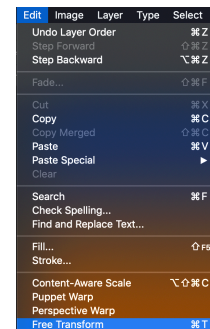
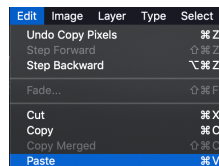
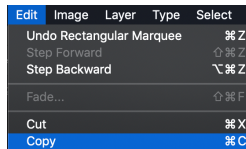
Choose **File > New** to create a new blank image. Specify image size based on the desired print size.

Choose **File > Open**, and open the first image (Image 1) to be added to the collage image. You now have the collage image and the first image (Image 1) open at the same time. Repeat the process until you have 4-5 images to use.



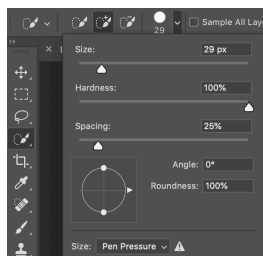
To extract a rectangle or circle, choose the **Marquee Tool**. After making a selection from the image, select **Edit > Copy** to copy selection.

Return to your document, select **Edit > Paste** to place the image. To resize the image, choose **Edit > Free Transform** or **control/T**.



To extract an irregular shaped object, use the **Quick Selection Tool**. Once selected, you can adjust the size of the tool in the panel above.

Click and drag the tool along the edges of the object you want to select. Be as precise as possible.



If your selection is not perfect, hold the **shift** key, and use the cursor to enlarge the selection. Draw along the edge.

To subtract, or make your selection smaller, hold the **alt** key, and use the cursor to pull the selection in.

To rearrange the order of the layers or the way the layers overlap, drag any layer in the **Layers** panel above or below another layer.
