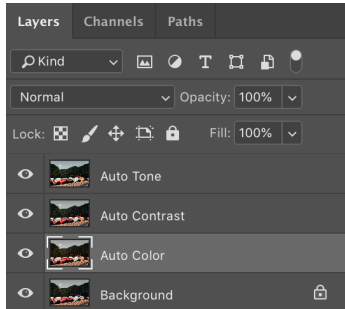


Layers

Auto Tone, Auto Contrast, Auto Color

Download a photo as jpeg from unsplash.com and open in Photoshop.

Find **Layers** panel. Right click **Background** layer. **Duplicate layer**. Title new **Layer** Auto Tone. Go to **Image** menu, drop down and select **Auto Tone**.

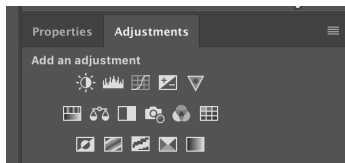


Repeat process with *Auto Contrast* and *Auto Color*

Click and drag white house beneath **Vibrance** to adjust.



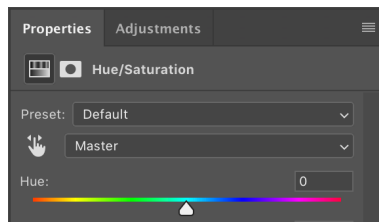
